MyLunchMoney.com is a new service to prepay for your child's school breakfast, lunch and a la carte food items using your credit card. The services will be implemented for all schools and parent usage by Aug. 3.

- Provide credit or debit card information.
- Select the **Automatic Pre-Payment** Option.
